The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CDF) is offering mountain bikers a unique opportunity to join the first CDF Volunteer Mountain Bike Unit. This unit is focused on fire prevention, public safety and education.

Each year, thousands of acres of California's outdoor recreation areas are ravaged by wildfires causing millions of dollars of damage. Homes are destroyed; lives are threatened and sometimes lost. Volunteers patrol selected high risk areas during declared critical fire days. Volunteers make preliminary wildland property inspection, providing homeowners with information to make their homes fire safe.

Ninety percent of all calls to CDF are non-fire related. Focused on prevention, the CDF Volunteer Mountain Bike Unit strives to increase public awareness of proper bicycle safety and trail etiquette. Additionally, volunteers will provide basic first aid when required. These efforts help to ensure a great experience for all recreational users.

With as little as 8 hours a month, you can assist the CDF in maintaining our local recreational parks and wildlands, offering continued enjoyment for all who venture outdoors.
